RE: AM2024/6 Variation of modern awards to include a delegates' rights term

On 10 May 2024, the President issued a Statement setting out a draft delegates' right term. Interested parties were invited to file submissions concerning the draft term by 12:00PM on Friday, 17 May 2024.

Chambers has received several requests from interested parties for an extension to provide their submissions on the draft workplace delegates' rights term.

Vice President Asbury has considered those requests. To ensure all interested parties have an opportunity to provide their submissions, the Vice President will grant an extension until **5:00PM AEST on Wednesday, 22 May 2024** for any interested party, including those parties who have already submitted, to provide their submissions on the draft workplace delegates' rights term.

As the Commission is required to make a determination varying modern awards to insert a delegates' rights term by 30 June 2024 and given the timeframe within which this matter is required to be determined, the Vice President advises that a further extension would unlikely be granted.

It would be appreciated if interested parties could lodge their submissions as soon as possible, and by no later than **5:00PM AEST on Wednesday, 22 May 2024**.
