Expense-related allowances.

A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amounts “\$18.23” and “\$14.53” appearing in clause 18.2(a)(i) and inserting “\$19.43” and “\$15.49” respectively.
2. By deleting the amounts “\$18.23” and “\$14.53” appearing in clause 18.2(a)(ii) and inserting “\$19.43” and “\$15.49” respectively.
3. By deleting the amount “\$0.95” appearing in clause 18.4(a)(i) and inserting “\$0.98”.
4. By deleting the amount “\$0.32” appearing in clause 18.4(a)(ii) and inserting “\$0.33”.
5. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.1.1 and inserting the following:

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2024. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee’s first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2024.
