Information note—*Pharmacy Industry Award 2020*: data discrepancy

On 30 August 2024, the Fair Work Commission published <u>Data profile</u> – Pharmacists and the *Pharmacy Industry Award 2020* (Data profile). This contained data on the characteristics of retail pharmacists and all pharmacists using data from the Australian Bureau of Statistics' (ABS) Census conducted in August 2021. The note stated that 68.4 per cent of retail pharmacists were female based on data from the Census.

The Pharmacy Guild of Australia submitted Attachments A and B which provide information on the number of pharmacists by gender. Two data sources are used—the ABS Census for August 2021 and the National Health Workforce Dataset (NHWDS), which is maintained by the Department of Health and Aged Care.

Based on the 2 different data sources presented in Attachments A and B, the calculation of the proportion of females who are pharmacists differs to the proportion calculated in the data profile.

Comparing the findings in Attachments A and B with the data profile finds that:

- The data profile considered *employees* only.
- The data in Attachment A covers *all* retail pharmacists, which includes non-employees, such as owner managers of incorporated and unincorporated enterprises or contributing family workers.
- The data in Attachment B are sourced from the NHWDS, which was not included in the data profile.

 These data may also include non-employees.

Tables 1 and 2 present the data and calculated proportions used in the data profile (employees only) with analysis of all retail pharmacists.

Table 1 shows that, when adding the number of retail pharmacists who are employees with non-employees, the results are similar to those submitted by the Pharmacy Guild of Australia. The small difference is due likely to the perturbation of Census data.¹

The data profile did not provide data from the NHWDS which is maintained by the Department of Health and Aged Care.

¹ To minimise the risk of identifying individuals in aggregate statistics, a technique has been developed to randomly adjust values, known as random error or perturbation and is considered to be the best technique for avoiding the release of identifiable data while maximising the range of information that can be released. The NHWDS is a combination of registration and survey data collected through the renewal process for registered health practitioners.² Some of these data were used in the <u>Information note - Gender undervaluation</u>: ACTU data request - ATSIHW Award prepared by staff of the Commission.

Unlike the Census, the survey undertaken for the NHWDS is voluntary (completed at the time of registration) potentially producing a smaller sample than the one obtained from the Census. Further, the sample taken from the NHWDS may also include non-employees, resulting in a smaller proportion of females. These data were also analysed by Commission staff and the proportion of retail pharmacists who were female was calculated to be 57.5 per cent in 2023, which is the same figure reported in Attachment B.
