Dear Associate

We write concerning the directions made on 28 October 2019 by his honour.

We are well advanced with our materials but will have some difficulty filing on Monday, 20 January 2020 due to leave arrangements and also the need to get the materials internally approved. In relation to the submission some additional time will be useful.

We ask that the first order be varied to allow the United Workers' Union to file its materials by close of business on Friday, 24 January 2020. We have corresponded with the Australian Security Industry Association concerning amended the directions and the association consents to the proposed variation provided that the employers are provided with a corresponding brief extension to 17 April 2020. We have no issue with this. We note the response of Mr Delany of ASIAL:

'I am instructed to advise that ASIAL agrees that given the timing your request for an extension is reasonable and (as Monday 13 April 2020 is Easter Monday) the employer parties be allowed an extension to Friday 17 April COB.'

Accordingly we ask that the orders be varied so that order 1 requires materials to be filed by '24 January 2020' and order 2 '17 April 2020'.
