During those proceedings, the Australian Industry Group (**Ai Group**) undertook to advise the Commission of its position in relation to the draft determination filed by the Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees' Association (**SDA**) on 22 March 2017 in relation to an alleged calculation error in the rates for casual console operators under clause 36.3 of the *Vehicle Manufacturing, Repair, Services and Retail Award 2010*.

Ai Group notes the agreement reached between the SDA and the Motor Trades Organisations in this regard. Ai Group does not oppose the agreement reached.
