Review of classification rates at the C14 and C13 level in modern awards – Manufacturing and Associated Industries and Occupations Award 2020 – award varied.

- A. Further to the decision issued by the Expert Panel on 19 November 2024 [[2024] FWCFB 438], the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By inserting clause A.4.3(a)(iii) as follows:
 - (iii) Within a period of 3 months, the employee will be reclassified to Engineering/Manufacturing Employee—Level II.
- 2. By deleting clause A.4.4(a)(i) and inserting the following:
 - (i) An Engineering/Manufacturing Employee—Level II is an employee who has completed up to 3 months' employment at Level I to enable the employee to perform work within the scope of this level.

- 3. By updating the cross-references accordingly.
- B. This determination comes into operation on 1 January 2025. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee's first full pay period that starts on or after 1 January 2025.
